**CONTRACT J107 – DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION OF JW1, JW2 AND VIADUCT FOR JURONG REGION LINE
– PREPARATORY WORKS FOR TRAFFIC DIVERSION**

The Land Transport Authority (LTA) has awarded Jurong Region Line (JRL) Contract J107 to **CES_SDC Pte. Ltd.** for the design and construction of JW1, JW2 and viaduct.

We would like to inform you that our contractor will be carrying out preparatory works for road diversion along Jurong West Street 75. To facilitate the preparatory works, please note that there will be trees removal, bus shelters relocation and pathway diversion works along Jurong West Street 75. They are listed below for your easy reference.

	Bus Stop / Pathway	Starting
1	Bus stop (ID 273279) in front of Block 755 to be relocated to location B1 (Refer to Annex A)	April 24, 2022 (between 12.00am and 05.00am)
2	Bus stop (ID: 27371) opposite Block 755 to be relocated to location B2 (Refer to Annex A)	May 22, 2022 (between 12.00am and 05.00am)
3	Existing footpath extending from the Bus Stop (ID: 27371) will be closed. (Refer to the yellow path with crosses on Annex A)	May 22, 2022 (between 12.00am and 05.00am)
4	New pedestrian walkway connecting 2 relocated bus stops, available for use. (Refer to the red path indicated on Annex A)	May 22, 2022
5	Existing cycling path near Block 755 will be closed in progressive stages to coincide with expansion of the footpath next to it.	Mid-March 2022
6	Footpath near Block 755 will be expanded to become a shared path for both cyclist and path users. (Refer to the green path on Annex A)	End March 2022
7	Tree removal works near Block 753 and 755	April 8, 2022

Please note that the dates and timing are subject to weather conditions and site constraints. Please refer to Annex A for more information of the works. Directional and information signs will be displayed in advance to inform and guide pedestrians and cyclists.
