

Kerjaya Prospek unit bags RM98.79 mil job to build private hospital in Seremban

KUALA LUMPUR (April 3): Kerjaya Prospek Group Bhd (KL:[KERJAYA](#) ASK [EDGE](#)) on Friday announced that its subsidiary has received a letter of award (LOA) worth RM98.79 million from Sena Letrik (M) Sdn Bhd to construct a private hospital in Seremban, Negeri Sembilan.

In a filing with Bursa Malaysia, the construction group said the LOA was awarded to its wholly-owned unit Kerjaya Prospek (M) Sdn Bhd and consists of works for an eight-storey building and a basement level with facilities.

Under the 18-month contract, Kerjaya Prospek (M) will be responsible for building as well mechanical, electrical, and external works of the complex.

Sena Letrik (M) is a mechanical and electrical contractor, and mainly serves the government and government-linked companies, according to its website. Their main works include installing lighting systems.

As of April 3, this is Kerjaya Prospek's third construction contract win for this year. Other wins include a RM201.25 million job for a mixed development project in Damansara Damai as well as a RM502.27 million contract for reclamation works in Penang.

At noon break, shares of Kerjaya Prospek Group were up by 1.4% or three sen to RM2.18 ahead of the announcement. At its last price, the group is valued at RM2.76 billion.
